## Service Center Cost Recovery Policy

Protocols that receive research study support from the Georgia CTSA are subject to fees according to the published cost recovery model on the Georgia CTSA website. Fees should be used for budget development to justify requests for support of studies being conducted at GCRC sites throughout Atlanta. The fee schedule is updated annually. Investigators with SAC approved protocols will be charged the published rate at the time service is provided.
